[OnlineGroups.Net](#) enables you to start your own online groups site and then add online groups. Trial groups are free. [OnlineGroups.Net](#) provides an alternative to Yahoo! Groups. They have no advertising and you can have them on your own site that can be customised to use your domain, and look and feel and your content.
